Annual District Meeting (Budget Vote/Election) will be conducted on **Tuesday, May 21, 2024**
from 12:00 noon – 8:00 p.m. in the foyer of the Rigby Gymnasium.

Board Member Qualifications

- Able to read and write
- Qualified voter of the district; that is, a citizen of the United States, at least 18 years of age or older, and not adjudged to be an incompetent.
- A Scio Central School District resident for a least one (1) full year prior to the election,
- May not have been removed from any school district office within the preceding year
- May not reside with another member of the same school board as a member of the same family
- May not be a current employee of the Scio Central School
- May not simultaneously hold another incompatible public office

Nominating Petitions for School Board Membership

- Petitions may be obtained by contacting the District Clerk
- Petitions must state the name and residence of the candidate and contain the name, address, and signature of at least 25 qualified district voters or two percent of the number of voters who voted in the previous annual election of the members of the school board, whichever is greater
- Petitions are due in the office of the district clerk no later than 5:00 p.m. on April 22, 2024 (30 days prior to the election)

Campaign Expenditure Statements

- The required expenditure statements must be submitted to the District Clerk at the following times:
 - April 22, 2024 – 30 days preceding the election
 - May 16, 2024 – 5 days preceding the election
 - June 10, 2024 – 20 days following the election

Other Information for Scio Central School:

- Board candidates run “at large”, the candidate with the most votes is elected to fill the open seats.
- There are two positions open for five-year terms.
- An oath of office is required to be filed.
- Mandatory training is required within the first year of service.
